



SCHOOLMASTER DRESSAGE CLINICS 2010

Clinic dates are as follows:

2 DAY (WEEKEND) COURSE Sat/Sun	4 DAY (MIDWEEK) COURSE Tues – Fri

Clinic details:

- Clients will receive two one hour lessons on each day of the course. The first lesson will be an individual lunge lesson. Thereafter the lesson content will be at the discretion of the instructor in discussion with the client and may be individual or in pairs.
- At least one lesson will be videoed and can be reviewed during a group workshop session. The timing of this can be tailored for each course. A presentation DVD of these videos and stills photographs of lessons will be given to clients to take home.
- Clients are asked to arrive at Dovecote Stables by 9.30am on the first day of the course, where they will receive a brief introduction and a timetable their lessons and have an opportunity to meet the horses and their instructor.
- Those clients bringing their own horse are requested to arrive the evening before if possible, no later than 7pm. Stable, bedding (straw) and haylage will be provided, but clients are requested to bring their own hard feed.
- Please bring a well fitting current safety standard hard hat and sensible riding wear. Gloves are also recommended. Body protectors are at the client's own discretion.
- We suggest you bring wet weather gear and also a sun hat and sun cream to guard against the vagaries of British weather. Clients wishing to change in and out of riding clothes on site can do so in the wash room.
- To ensure you get the most out of the event, please bring plenty to eat and drink; there is a fridge available for use, plus tea and coffee making facilities.
- The more information you provide in advance about your hopes and ambitions, the better we can match you with the right horse and ensure the right content.
- Clients are reminded that the horses at Dovecote Stables are schoolmasters and so not suitable for complete beginners, however they are chosen for their temperaments and obedience and we believe they give riders an exceptional experience and feel.

Terms and Conditions/Disclaimer

This disclaimer becomes a contract between Dovecote Stables and the signatory (hereinafter referred to as The Participant) relating to attendance and participation at any Dovecote Stables event.

For the Purposes of these Terms:

An event is any training, lecture, demonstration, or social function organised by Dovecote Stables. For the purposes of event bookings Dovecote Stables also includes any person who may assist in running the course and/or has an interest in the property/venue at which an event is held.

1. Completion of a booking form does not necessarily indicate acceptance of the booking by Dovecote Stables since some events may only be suitable for limited numbers of participants and acceptance is at the discretion of Dovecote Stables
2. Unless otherwise stated, bookings will be taken on a first come first served basis.
3. A deposit is required at the time of booking and will be returned in full if the booking is not accepted. The balance should be payable upon arrival.
4. Neither Dovecote Stables nor any Dovecote Stables facilitator accepts any liability whatsoever, for death of, or injury to, any equine attending with and/or belonging to The Participant, howsoever caused.
5. Neither Dovecote Stables nor any Dovecote Stables facilitator accepts any liability whatsoever, for loss or damage to property of The Participant or any person who may accompany The Participant to the event, howsoever caused.
6. Dovecote Stables advises The Participant that equines can be unpredictable and activities involving equines may be hazardous. Dovecote Stables recommends personal accident insurance.
7. Dovecote Stables advises The Participant that he/she may be personally liable for loss or injury caused to other horses, people or property by either him/her, or any equine or other person attending the event with him/her. Dovecote Stables recommends public liability insurance.
8. If the Participant is unable to attend an event for which he/she has booked, he/she will be entitled to a full refund of the deposit, providing notice of cancellation is given at least ten days prior to the event in question. Dovecote Stables accepts no liability whatsoever for other expenses, howsoever incurred.
9. If a booked event is cancelled or postponed, Dovecote Stables will reimburse The Participant in full for any booking fees paid but accepts no liability whatsoever for other expenses, howsoever incurred.
10. Dovecote Stables reserves the right to revoke its approval for The Participant to attend an event and in such a case will reimburse The Participant in full for any booking fees paid, but accepts no liability whatsoever for other expenses, howsoever incurred.
11. This agreement amounts to the renunciation of a right of legal action by The Participant against either Dovecote Stables or any Dovecote Stables facilitator and it shall be binding upon The Participant, the Participant's legal representative, heirs and next of kin and may be pleaded in bar to any cause of action commenced in any court, that is contrary to its terms and conditions.
